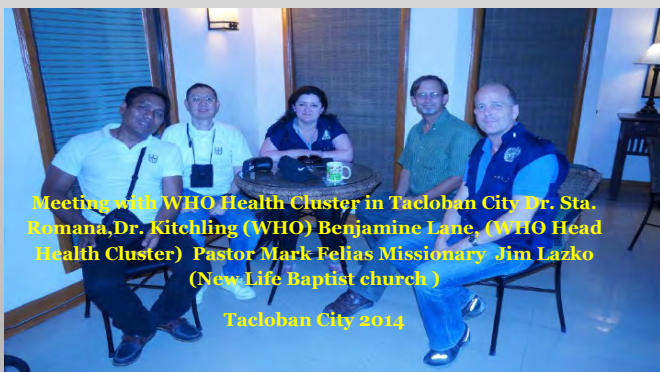

PROJECT: HOSPITAL SHIP

Faced with this limiting reality, a solution must be arrived at with even the most frivolous ideas on hand. Thus, a retired navy aircraft carrier converted into a hospital ship is a very viable option. The Hospital Ship will not just be for the Philippines. It is geared toward the Southeast Asia and to where natural disaster-related mission is needed.
